Dear Director Howland:

Please accept this letter as a supplement to Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy's above referenced petition for a license for the 391 Line to cross public waters and State-owned land. The petition filed under cover letter dated January 28, 2020 incorrectly referred to "Public Land Span" with regard to the Isinglass River crossing in Section 5, when said reference should have been to "Public Waters Span".

Said Petition at Section 5 also identified the State-owned land span in Rochester, depicted on Exhibit 2, as 75', when in fact that crossing span is 116'. Enclosed herewith is a replacement Exhibit 2 depicting said State-owned land crossing in Rochester, where the horizontal distance of the crossing span has been revised to 116'.

There are no further revisions to the Petition or supporting Exhibits at this time.
