**Re: Docket No. DE 20-053; Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Energy Service Rates for the Period February 1, 2021, through July 31, 2021, for the Large Customer Group and the Small Customer Group**

I enclose for filing one redacted and one confidential *revised* versions of Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty's proposed Energy Service rates for the Large Customer Group and the Small Customer Group for the six-month period February 1, 2021, through July 31, 2021.

This filing includes the direct testimony and schedules of John D. Warshaw and a technical statement and schedules of Adam M. Hall and David B. Simek, which contain minor changes to the original filing made December 7, 2020. Mr. Warshaw's testimony describes the process used to procure Energy Service for both the Large and Small Customer Groups, the proposed Energy Service rates, and how the Company proposes to meet its 2020 Renewable Portfolio Standard obligations. Messrs. Hall and Simek present the Company's proposed Energy Service rates and bill impacts.

Certain schedules included in the energy service rate filing contain confidential information, specifically, the Company's transaction confirmations with the winning suppliers, bid evaluation and summary, REC pricing, and retail meter commodity cost calculations. The Company requests confidential treatment of these materials pursuant to Puc 201.06(a)(15) and 201.07, which collectively afford confidential treatment of such materials in routine Energy Service filings as a matter of course. The Company also requests confidential treatment of the wholesale power purchase prices included in this filing only until such time those prices are required to be made public by the FERC.



The Company believes the proposed Energy Service rates are consistent with RSA 374-F:3,V(c) and Commission precedent, and are in the public interest as reflective of “competitive market” prices. See NH RSA 374-F:3,V(c). Accordingly, the Company respectfully asks that the Commission approve the proposed rates to become effective for service on and after February 1, 2021.

Pursuant to the Commission’s March 17, 2020, secretarial letter, only an electronic version of this filing will be provided.
