Petition for Recovery of Storm Expenses


Dear Director Howland:

On May 1, 2020 Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) submitted its petition for recovery of storm expenses pertaining to storm events from October 2018 through August 2019. On April 20, 2021 the Commission’s Staff recommended recovery of the requested storm expenses subject to certain adjustments. On May 12, 2021, the Commission issued a secretarial letter approving the amounts specified in the Staff’s recommendation. As part of its letter, the Commission also stated that “Eversource shall notify Staff when the Company has made the required adjustments and confirm the final adjusted amount of recovery and the resulting balance of the MSCR fund.” May 12, 2021 Secretarial Letter at 1.

By this letter, Eversource is informing the Commission that on June 10, 2021, Eversource notified the Staff that it had made the required adjustments and confirmed the amount of the recovery and the balance of the MSCR fund. For clarity, the total amount of recovered costs is \$14,922,043 which reflects the balance of costs noted in the Commission’s letter as updated with the application of the appropriate carrying charges through May 2021.
