
Dear Director Howland:

On July 10, 2020, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) submitted its petition and supporting testimony and exhibits pertaining to its request to adjust its Transmission Cost Adjustment Mechanism (“TCAM”). Due to a calculation error relating to rate information pertaining to its Stranded Cost Adjustment Mechanism (“SCRC”) certain schedules in the TCAM filing, along with a minor portion of the testimony of Jennifer A. Ullram, require updating. Specifically, the information describing overall rate impacts to customers is being updated. An update to the SCRC to correct the same error is being submitted in Docket No. DE 20-095 contemporaneously with this submission.

Accordingly, enclosed for filing are updates to Bates pages 50 and 60-63 of Eversource’s TCAM submission. Eversource requests that these pages be inserted in place of those provided on July 10, 2020. The remainder of Eversource’s TCAM filing beyond the identified pages is unaffected by this submission, and Eversource’s rate request in this docket is unchanged by this submission.
