WHEREAS: The "Stewardship of Natural Resources" chapter of Dover's Master Plan commits a full

section to examining our energy use in Dover and identifying energy efficiency initiatives and new energy sources that will better serve the citizens. The plan also contains action to: "Provide education, outreach, and incentives to encourage developers and homeowners

to pursue energy conservation measures on their properties"; and

WHEREAS: The State of New Hampshire's 2021-2023 New Hampshire Statewide Energy Efficiency Plan

outlines the effort by the State to promote programs that provide energy savings, promote economic development, reduce the need for additional capacity investments, and protect the natural environment by reducing the amount of carbon dioxide ("CO2") and sulfur and nitrogen oxides released into the atmosphere due to reduced energy generation and

WHEREAS: The 2021-2023 New Hampshire Statewide Energy Efficiency Plan will save \$1.3 billion in energy

costs and is estimated to support over 4,000 jobs; and

WHEREAS: A key aspect of this program is the NHSaves initiative. NHSaves is an efficiency plan

from the State's major utilities with electric and gas savings goals for 2021 to 2023 through

rebates, audits, and incentives; and

WHEREAS: The NHSaves program also includes \$77 million for income-eligible programs, helping

those who need it most to weatherize their homes, update heating systems, and replace inefficient appliances, providing critical assistance to lower income families all over the

State; and

WHEREAS: Members of the NH House Science, Technology, Energy Committee have recently

requested that the NH Public Utilities Commission (NHPUC) indefinitely postpone the

implementation of this program; and

WHEREAS: Elimination of this program will have a devastating impact on energy conservation efforts

and will cripple efforts that keep lower income households warm and provide critical

assistance to those in need.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND DOVER CITY COUNCIL THAT:

The City of Dover fully supports continuation of the NHSaves program as laid out in the 2021-2023 New Hampshire Statewide Energy Efficiency Plan, this plan has been acted on by the
