Dear Chairwoman Martin:

On August 30, 2021, intervenors Village Shores Estates (VSE) and Tioga, Belmont (TB) filed a motion to dismiss in this docket. The very next day, on August 31, 2021, the intervenors circulated the attached email withdrawing that motion. The docket book does not yet reflect this August 31, 2021 withdrawal. Therefore, Abenaki Water Company, Inc. (Abenaki) is filing this withdrawal to ensure that the Commission's records reflect the intervenors' intention and to preserve Abenaki's rights that it believes there is no pending motion to dismiss to respond to.

In the withdrawal, the intervenors discuss their intention to address directly with Abenaki the issue of whether to continue the rate case. Since then, on September 7, 2021, the Commission, under its authority of RSA 378:5 to investigate rate cases, requested data from Abenaki and set an October 7, 2021 due date. Therefore, Abenaki is responding to that data request which requires that this proceeding be considered open.
