PETITION OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF NEW HAMPSHIRE D/B/A EVERSOURCE ENERGY FOR LICENSE TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN ELECTRIC LINES OVER AND ACROSS LANDS OWNED BY THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE IN THE TOWNS OF PETERBOROUGH AND TEMPLE, NEW HAMPSHIRE

Dear Director Howland:

Enclosed for filing with the Commission in Docket 20-115, please find Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy's supplemental petition and Exhibits 1 through 11A, encompassing the following revisions discussed with the PUC's Safety Division:

- Project scope expanded to include the so-called "Summit Solution", comprising additional State owned land crossed as described on the crossing span summary added to Exhibit 0 and as depicted on replacement Exhibit 11 and 11A;
- Exhibit 0, Note 4 is revised to restate the total distance of State owned land crossed excluding NHDOT ROW as 5,158.6';
- Summary table of individual span distances and NHDOT ROW area deducts, together with cable specifications for each span, added to Exhibit 0;
- Exhibit 1 revised to include the southerly boundary of the DOT boundary for Rte.101/Wilton Rd. in the Profile View and vertical clearance measurement added for span between said boundary and Pole 37/47;
- A new Exhibit 5a is enclosed which depicts the spur from the main circuit between Str. 81/13 and Str. 81/13X in Profile View;
- A new Exhibit 11a is enclosed which depicts the spurs to the DES building and 1 Story Brick State Police building in greater detail;
- Paragraph 1 and New Paragraph 9 of the Petition revised to reference six State owned parcels crossed: Peterborough Map R001-015-000; Peterborough Map R001-017-

001; Temple Map 1-11; Temple Map 1-12; Temple Map 1-1A; and Peterborough Map R001-019-000;

- New Paragraph 2 of the Petition revised to describe the scope of pole replacement and installation with greater clarity;
- New Paragraphs 3 through 6 added to the petition to describe portions of the secondary services to the State Police Building, FAA Building, MIT Building and DES Buildings which are located on State owned land and whose location have been more clearly depicted on the replacement Exhibits referenced in said paragraphs.
- New Paragraph 9 of the Petition revised to revise the total structure span of 5565.5 and total State owned land distance crossed of 5,149.6 consistent with the addition of individual span and DOT ROW deducted areas summarized on the tables added to Exhibit 0;
- New Paragraph 11 changed the reference to the 2017 NESC, to the 2012 NESC.
- New Paragraph 15 supplemented with a statement describing nearby property owner The Nature Conservancy's participation in the project design.
