The Association's water is supplied by wells on the grounds of the Association and managed by the Hampstead Area Water Company. It is a stand-alone system and does not receive any outside resources of the Hampstead Water Company, other than management and maintenance of the system Therefore, the system should not be encumbered by capital infrastructure and operating costs of the larger systems operated by Hampstead – for only those systems benefit directly from the proposed cost increase

The cost increases suggested in the ORDER # 26,437 are at the very least 30% or more to the unit owner. There is no benefit received by the unit owner.

The unit owners are all aware of the changes taking place due to climate and weather changes and appreciate the value of potable water...but a 30% increase is not justified. The lawns at the condominium are not watered because of the concern over the value of water

As we are a 55+ Association, the majority of owners are on fixed incomes.....and a 30% increase can be a notable impact on budgets.

Direct communication with Hampstead water has been futile.
