**Petition for License to Construct and Maintain Electric Lines Over and Across the North
Branch of the Sugar River in Croydon, and Land Owned by the State of New Hampshire
in Croydon, Newport, and Claremont**

Pursuant to Order No. 26,455 issued in this proceeding on February 10, 2021, I, Erik Newman, Senior Counsel for Eversource Energy, do hereby certify:

1. On February 12, 2021, Eversource provided a copy of this Order to (i) the Town Clerks of Croydon and Newport, and the City Clerk of Claremont; (ii) the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services; and (iii) the New Hampshire Attorney General and all owners of the land bordering on said public waters at the crossing location in Croydon, by first class mail, as required by RSA 371:19, with the exception of owners of assessor parcels 14-601 and 17-518 abutting the Sugar River crossing span in Croydon whom the Croydon assessor has no record of ownership available online and assessor parcel 17-517, for which the Croydon assessor identifies the owner as Barbara Kreese and Sarah Richardson, but for whom no owner mailing address is provided. Eversource will continue to research ownership and contact addresses for said lots and will supply notice of the Order upon confirmation and an updated affidavit certifying either the date of notice mailing or inability to determine contact for purposes of notice
2. On February 11, 2021, one business day after February 10, 2021 a copy of the order was published on the portion of Eversource's website dedicated to such notices. A screenshot of that page is attached to verify that the order has been published.
