**Re: DG 20-141; Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty
 2020-2021 Winter Period Cost of Gas – February 2021 Monthly COG Adjustment**

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. (the “Company”) and in accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the “Commission”) Order No. 26,419 (October 30, 2020) in Docket No. DG 20-141, I enclose for filing the Company’s (February) calculation of its projected collection of gas costs for the 2020-2021 winter season ending April 30, 2021.

The calculation reflects the estimated February 2021 NYMEX settled forward prices as of January 21, 2021. The resulting projected over collection of approximately \$1,623,666 is 3.84% of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2020-2021 winter season.

Liberty elects to implement a rate change for the February 1, 2021, billing cycle. The current Cost of Gas rates are listed in the table below.
