Objection to Husband Expansion of Scope of Issues

Dear Director Howland:

Pursuant to the Commission's temporary filing requirements, N.H. Admin. R. Puc 203.07, and the Commission's order at the January 27, 2021 prehearing in this matter, attached please find Pennichuck East Utility, Inc.'s (PEU) objection to intervenor Husband's request to expand the scope of issues for this proceeding.

As stated at the prehearing, now that the Towns of Litchfield, Londonderry, Pelham, and Hooksett have stated that they are no longer intervening "on behalf of the citizen customers within each of the Towns", PEU does not object to the granting of the intervention requests of the individual Litchfield customers, including Mr. Husband, as a matter of right under RSA 541-A:32, I so long as the intervenors' participation stays within the issues noticed in this proceeding.

For completeness, PEU does not object to the other intervention request, that of Attorney Myers and Farmstead customers in the Town of Derry. PEU agrees to their intervention as a matter of right.
