Dear Chairman Goldner:

Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (the “Company”) submits this letter in response to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission’s March 10, 2023 procedural order directing the Company to file its responses to three record requests by close of business on March 17, 2023.

The Company is diligently preparing its responses to the record requests. However, due to a winter storm predicted to impact the Company’s service territory, a Level 3 Emergency Response Plan (“ERP”) Event has been declared beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, March 13, 2023. As a result, the key personnel responsible for preparing responses to the record requests will be on “storm duty;” storm duty is currently anticipated to last most of this week. The Company will make every effort to file its responses to the record requests as soon as possible; however, due to this anticipated severe weather event, the Company respectfully requests a two-business day extension of time to file its responses until close of business on Tuesday, March 21, 2023. This is still five (5) weeks prior to the next hearing date in this matter.
