Procedural Order Re: CENH Petition for Intervention

On June 13, 2022, Clean Energy New Hampshire (CENH), a nonprofit organization that advocates for sustainable energy in New Hampshire, filed an unsigned petition to intervene in this docket. CENH refiled its signed petition to intervene on June 22, 2022. CENH represented that Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource), the New Hampshire Department of Energy, and the Office of the Consumer Advocate do not object to its late intervention request.

In its petition, CENH asserted that it has a strong interest in matters concerning electric vehicles, grid modernization, interconnection of distributed energy resources, net metering, energy storage, and non-wires-alternatives. Further, CENH stated that it has 500 members, including residential, municipal, and business customers of Eversource whose rights, duties, privileges, immunities, or other substantial interests will be affected by the Commission's decisions in this docket. CENH maintained that its intervention would be in the interests of justice and would not affect the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceeding. It requested that it be granted full intervenor status and agreed to abide by the current procedural schedule.


The Commission has GRANTED CENH's request to intervene, finding that the standard for intervention in RSA 541-A:32 has been met. *See* N.H. Admin. R., Puc 203.17. CENH shall comply with the remainder of the existing procedural schedule approved by

the procedural order dated March 25, 2022, as well as the attached, revised hearing guidelines.
