On October 12, 2020, the Commission issued an Order of Notice (the "Order") opening an Investigation into Compensation of Energy Storage Projects for Avoided Transmission and Distribution Costs. Citing RSA 374-H:2, II, the Order sets forth a series of issues regarding compensation for, and investment in, energy storage projects, and solicits comments on said issues from electric distribution companies and other interested stakeholders.
