Public Service of New Hampshire Company d/b/a Eversource (“Eversource”), hereby submits the following filing in compliance with the Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) Order No. 26,604 Approving Distribution Utilities Electric Vehicle TOU Rates (“Order”).

The Order at page 26 states:

FURTHER ORDERED, that Eversource shall develop proposals for a two-period TOU rate for separately metered EV charging residential customers and a three-period TOU rate for separately metered EV charging commercial customers, and file to those proposed rates with the Commission within 90 days of this order, together with estimates of costs to implement, as directed herein.
