On November 9, 2020, Teleport Communications of America LLC (TCAL) filed a safety valve request to overturn the October 27 denial by Somos of its request for two blocks of contiguous numbers in the Rochester rate center. TCAL states that it has a customer looking to increase its utilization of number resources. TCAL supported its assertion with a letter of intent and explanation from the customer.

The Rochester exchange has appropriate, unassigned thousand-number blocks that would meet TCAL's needs. Staff recommends that the Commission grant TCAL's request for a safety valve waiver.
