Dear Ms. Howland:

I am writing on behalf of Teleport Communications of America LLC (“TCAL”) to make a supplemental safety valve request of the Commission in this docket. After TCAL made its original request to the Commission, it learned that its customer, a leading national provider of health care services, needed 3,000 additional contiguous numbers. These additional numbers will be used for a different IP Flex dialing plan than the 2,000 numbers at issue in TCAL’s original request. The customer will activate the numbers as soon as they are effective and successfully tested. The customer’s letter of intent is enclosed as Exhibit 1.

The request for resources was submitted to the Pooling Administrator, and the denial from Somos is enclosed as Exhibit 2. Accordingly, please accept this supplemental safety valve request to overturn the denial by Somos of TCAL’s request for 3,000 contiguous numbers in the Rochester rate center.
