Dear Attorney Chiavara:

Aquarion Water Company of New Hampshire, Inc. (Aquarion) submitted compliance tariff pages pursuant to Order No. 26,761 (January 19, 2023) on April 5, 2023, which replaced an earlier filing of these pages on March 14, 2023. The Commission requires additional information about the changes on two of these pages to determine whether they are compliant. The Commission will finalize its review after receiving a response from Aquarion to this letter.

On the Sixth Revised Page 12, Aquarion removed the "Per Quarter" column from the chart for service charges. This change does not appear to be authorized in Order No. 26,761 or in the November 21, 2022 stipulation approved in that order. Aquarion did not explain why it made this change in either its March 14 or April 5, 2023 cover letters. Accordingly, the Commission requests that Aquarion supplement its tariff filing to clarify why it removed this column from the tariff page.

On the Sixth Revised Page 14, Aquarion added two columns to the chart for water rates for private fire service, one labeled "Step," which appears to show the annual rates after the implementation of the step adjustment, and one labeled "Current," which appears to show the annual rates prior to the step adjustment. This change does not appear in the accompanying redline of the tariff page. This change does not appear to be authorized in Order No. 26,761 or in the November 21, 2022 stipulation approved in that order. Aquarion did not explain why it made this change in either its March 14 or April 5, 2023 cover letters.

In the Commission's view, these two columns might confuse customers because the meaning of the labels "Step" and "Current," without further explanation, could be lost on lay persons. In

Tel. (603) 271-2431 Website: addition, the column labeled "Current" is confusing because it does not reflect rates as of the effective date of the page. Finally, it is unclear why including the pre-step adjustment rates is either necessary or helpful. Accordingly, the Commission requests that Aquarion either remove these columns or provide an explanation as to why it included them in the revised tariff page.

In accordance with the Secretarial letter issued March 17, 2020, this letter will be filed electronically only at this time.
