**RE: Wolfeboro WMED Response- IR 22-053 New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission
Investigation in Electric Power Procurement**

Dear Mr. Goldner,

For the last 20 years the Town of Wolfeboro Municipal Electric Department has procured 100% of its wholesale electric energy requirements from a single supplier through a load-following energy purchase contract. The term of each contract has been five years, and each contract has been procured through a competitive solicitation involving multiple potential wholesale suppliers. The town meets its obligations for Forward Capacity and ancillary services through the ISO-NE market, pays ISO-NE for Regional Network transmission service and EVERSOURCE of New Hampshire for local network transmission and distribution service. The Electric Department does not offer fixed term prices for electric service. However, the nature of the power contracts permits the Electric Department to set rates every five years and not change them until the next power contract has been procured.

The rate schedules provided for different customers do not include any time-varying elements other than a separate rate for off-peak water heating. All rates include a fixed monthly customer charge, a distribution charge in cents per kWh (large commercial customers also pay a distribution demand charge) and a Generation Charge which is the same for all customers.
