**Request for Emergency Temporary Rates for Merrimack Village District**

**Procedural Order Re: Motion to Approve Procedural Schedule**

On January 31, 2023, Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. (PWW) filed, pursuant to Order No. 26,597, a reconciliation between the actual variable rates for emergency bulk water supplies to the Merrimack Village District (MVD) under a special contract effective October 20, 2021 through December 31, 2022 and the amounts MVD actually paid. On March 6, 2023, PWW, with the assent of the New Hampshire Department of Energy (DOE), proposed the following procedural schedule for the DOE's review of the reconciliation:

DOE Data Requests to PWW – Set 5	April 11, 2023
PWW Responses – Set 5	April 21, 2023
Virtual Technical Session (if necessary)	May 1, 2023, at 10 a.m.
DOE Report to the Commission	May 16, 2023

It has been determined that the proposed procedural schedule is in the public interest and, therefore, it is approved.
