**2022 Intrastate Access Filings by Registered Telephone Utilities**


**Procedural Order Re: Request for DOE Recommendation**


On October 9, 2020, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) issued its decision in *In the Matter of 8YY Access Charge Reform*, in which it required each “Rate-of-Return Carrier” to reduce its interstate and intrastate rates, effective July 1, 2022, for: (1) “all originating End Office Access Service rate elements for Toll Free Calls in each state in which it provides such service;” and (2) “Toll Free Database Query Charges.” 35 FCC Rcd. 11594 (2020) (amending 47 C.F.R. § 51.909(o), contained in Appendix A) (FCC Order). A number of telecommunications providers submitted their compliance filings in this docket.

Certain telecommunications providers are required to register with the New Hampshire Department of Energy (DOE). Accordingly, the Commission requests that the DOE review these submissions to determine whether compliance filings have been received from all telecommunications providers that are regulated in New Hampshire and are subject to the FCC Order. In addition, the DOE is requested to determine whether the filings comply with the FCC Order and provide a recommendation of what further actions may be required in this docket by November 14, 2022.
