# January 2001 Retail Delivery Rate Filing Order Approving Retail Delivery Rates

APPEARANCES: Gallagher, Callahan and Gartrell by Seth L. Shortlidge, Esq. for Granite State Electric Company, and Tracy Guyette and James J. Cunningham Jr. for the Staff of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission.

On December 1, 2000, Granite State Electric Company (GSEC or the Company) filed with the Commission a petition to adjust retail rates effective January 1, 2001. The petition seeks to adjust GSEC's Stranded Cost Charge, Transition Service Charge, Transmission Charge, Electric Service Adjustment Factor, Distribution Surcharge Factor and System Benefits Charge. On December 5, 2000, the Commission issued an Order of Notice scheduling a hearing on December 20, 2000. No petitions for intervention were filed.

The filing represents a substantial increase in costs to customers of GSEC, much of which can be ascribed to the rise in fuel prices for electric generation. The Commission will approve the Company's revised rates as filed on December 1, 2000 in TMB-25. A more extensive order addressing the issues raised by the filing will be issued

shortly.

## Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the rates filed on December 1, 2000 in Granite State Electric Company's January 2001 Retail Rate Filing are approved as filed with an effective date of January 1, 2001; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that the Petitioner shall file a compliance tariff with the Commission on or before January 18, 2001 in accordance with N.H. Admin. Rules, Puc 1603.02(b).
