# Tariff Filing to Introduce Optional Calling Features

# Order Suspending Tariff

#### <u>O R D E R N O. 23,718</u>

# June 1, 2001

On April 27, 2001, Hollis Telephone Company submitted a tariff filing to introduce optional enhanced features, specifically, "Enhanced Caller Name with Wait" and "Enhanced Caller Number with Wait," each with a corresponding monthly rate of \$1.00, effective June 1, 2001. These features take advantage of existing digital switch functionality and allow the Call Wait feature to work with the existing Caller ID features.

Staff has reviewed the tariff and recommended approval, finding that because of the low cost of provisioning the service, the pricing of the service at the \$1.00 rate will more than recover its costs. The Commission, however, is concerned as to whether or not the tariff rate is just and reasonable. In order to adequately analyze the issue, the Commission has determined to suspend the tariff, per RSA 378:6, IV, for a period of 30 days.

# Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby

ORDERED, that Hollis Telephone Company's tariff

filing is suspended for an additional period of 30 days to allow for further analysis concerning the appropriate price to be charged for the proposed tariffed services.
