Order <u>Nisi</u> Modifying Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions

February 28, 2003

On April 12, 2002, the Commission issued Order No. 23,948 in this docket, setting rates for Loop Conditioning in Verizon's Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions (SGAT), and ordering a phase-out of those rates over a three-year period.

During the course of a related docket, Docket No. DT 02-228, regarding Multiple Loop Conditioning, Commission Staff became aware that a scrivener's error had occurred in Order No. 23,948. As a result, the loop conditioning rate contained in Order No. 23,948 is higher than the rate that would have been produced by modifying Verizon's submitted cost study in DT 01-206 pursuant to the order. We have been advised by Staff that the error resulted in a relatively small dollar difference, and therefore a retroactive change is not recommended as the administrative cost of the change would outweigh the savings.

We issue this order to correct the error, with the correction to take effect 30 days after this order is issued.
