Petition for License to Cross the Warner River in the Towns of Webster and Sutton

Summary of Order *Nisi* No. 25,787 Granting Water Crossing License

May 11, 2015

On May 11, 2015, the Commission granted Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource) a license, pursuant to RSA 371:17, to reconstruct and maintain electric lines over and across the public waters of the Warner River in two separate locations, in the Towns of Webster and Sutton. The reconstruction of these crossings is necessitated by the rebuilding of circuit running between Webster and Bradford, including the replacement of existing poles and conductors. The Commission Staff recommended that the license be granted subject to certain conditions. The petition and subsequent docket filings including the Commission's order, other than any information for which confidential treatment is requested of or granted by the Commission, are posted to the Commission's website at <a href="http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Docketbk/2015/15-088.html">http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Docketbk/2015/15-088.html</a>.

To ensure that all interested persons receive notice of this matter and have the opportunity to comment or request a hearing, the Commission delayed the effectiveness of its approval until June 10, 2015. All persons interested in responding to the Commission's approval may submit their comments or file a written request for a hearing, which states the reason and basis for a hearing, no later than May 28, 2015. Any person interested in responding to any such comment or request for hearing shall do so no later than June 4, 2015. Following consideration

of any comments and requests for hearing received, the Commission may further extend the final effective date of its approval. The Commission's approval shall otherwise become final and effective on June 10, 2015, unless the Commission orders otherwise.
