Voluntary Withdrawal of Registration Approved

Dear Ms. Kartychak:

On June 6, 2018, Consolidated Edison Solutions, Inc. (ConEd Solutions) filed with the Commission a request to voluntarily withdraw its registration as a competitive electric power supplier (CEPS). In that request, ConEd Solutions referenced its September 9, 2016 notification to the Commission of the purchase by Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon) of ConEd Solutions' retail commodity business, effective as of September 1, 2016. ConEd Solutions stated that New Hampshire customers were being served by Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. (CNE), an Exelon affiliate, as of that time. On June 8, 2018, ConEd Solutions provided supplemental information to support its request, including confirmation that its customers were "transitioned over" to CNE by November 17, 2017.


Commission Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum on June 14, 2019, summarizing ConEd Solutions' withdrawal request and supplemental information provided, as well as Staff's analysis of the circumstances related to ConEd Solutions' transfer of customer accounts to CNE and its compliance with applicable provisions of the Commission's rules. Staff noted that ConEd Solutions had not fully met the registration withdrawal requirements, under N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2003.08(a)(2) and Puc 2004.13(a)(7), because its notice of account transfer did not inform customers of the option to select an alternate supplier or utility default service by a specified date. Notwithstanding that technical deficiency in the account transfer notice, Staff recommended that the Commission grant a waiver of the specific notice requirement and approve ConEd Solutions' request for voluntary withdrawal of its registration, in view of the absence of customer complaints, the minimal actual harm to customer interests, and the passage of time since its operations ceased.

The Commission has reviewed ConEd Solution's request to voluntarily withdraw its CEPS registration and Staff's recommendation that rules waivers be granted to permit that withdrawal. The Commission has granted waivers of Puc 2003.08(a)(2) and Puc 2004.13(a)(7), with respect to the notice of account transfer sent to ConEd Solutions' customers, having found that those rules waivers will serve the public interest and not disrupt the orderly and efficient resolution of matters before the Commission, under Puc 201.05.

Accordingly, ConEd Solutions' CEPS registration is deemed withdrawn and terminated, and its related financial security obligations may be released, effective as of June 30, 2019.

Please be advised that registration withdrawal does not affect a supplier's obligation to comply with the Renewable Portfolio Standard with respect to any electricity sales made during the current or preceding calendar year, under RSA 362-F and N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2500.
