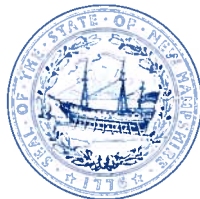

On October 1, 2018, the Commission issued a secretarial letter requiring Liberty to respond to the complaint filed by Judith Tompson by October 9, 2018. On October 12, 2018, Liberty notified the Commission that it had not received that secretarial letter, but had discovered it while on the Commission's website for another purpose. Liberty requested that the original secretarial letter be re-issued with a new response deadline.
